

UIL Eligibility Calendar HEB ISD Compliance Schedule 2025 - 2026

August 13	<p>School Begins</p> <p>All students meeting the UIL requirements of promotion or earned credits are academically eligible.</p> <p>These requirements are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Grade nine and below. Students must have been promoted from the previous grade.• Second year of high school. 5 accumulated credits that count toward state graduation requirements.• Third year of high school. Ten accumulated credits that count toward state graduation requirements or student must have earned at least 5 credits within the last twelve months that count toward state graduation requirements.• Fourth year of high school. Fifteen accumulated credits that count toward state graduation requirements or student must have earned at least 5 credits within the last twelve months that count toward state graduation requirements.
September 19	End of First Six Weeks. All grades must be checked.
September 22-26	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until end of school day on September 26 th .
September 26	At the end of the school day, anyone with a failing grade on September 19 th becomes ineligible for three school weeks. Anyone who was failing but is now passing all classes regains eligibility.
October 10	Anyone ineligible must have all grades checked and be passing all courses, not just the one or more they failed.
October 15-17	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until end of school day on September 17 th
October 17	Those who had been ineligible and passed all courses become eligible at the end of the school day.
October 31	End of Second Six Weeks. All grades must be checked.
Nov 4 -Nov 7	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until end of school day on November 7 th .
November 7	At the end of the school day, anyone with a failing grade on October 31 st becomes ineligible for three school weeks. Anyone who was failing but is now passing all classes regains eligibility.
November 21	Anyone ineligible must have all grades checked and be passing all courses, not just the one or more they failed.
November 21	When school is out everyone is academically eligible through Saturday, November 29 th .
Dec 1 – Dec 8	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until end of school day on December 8 th .
December 8	Those who had been ineligible and passed all courses become eligible at the end of the school day.
December 19	End of Third Six Weeks. All grades must be checked.
December 19	When school is out everyone is academically eligible through Monday, January 5 th .

January 6- 13	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until end of school day on January 13 th .
January 13	Those who had been ineligible and passed all courses become eligible at the end of the school day.
January 13	At the end of the school day, anyone with a failing grade on December 19 th becomes ineligible for three school weeks. Anyone who was failing but is now passing all classes regains eligibility.
January 26	Anyone ineligible must have all grades checked and be passing all courses, not just the one or more they failed.
Jan 26-Feb 2	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until end of school day on February 2 nd .
February 2	Those who had been ineligible and passed all courses become eligible at the end of the school day.
February 13	End of Fourth Six Weeks. All grades must be checked.
February 17-20	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until school is out on February 20 th .
February 20	At the end of the school day, anyone with a failing grade on February 20 th becomes ineligible for three school weeks. Anyone who was failing but is now passing all classes regains eligibility.
March 6	Anyone ineligible must have all grades checked and be passing all courses, not just the one or more they failed.
March 9-13	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until end of school day on March 13 th .
March 13	Those who had been ineligible and passed all courses become eligible at the end of the school day.
March 13	When school is out everyone is academically eligible through Saturday, March 21 st .
April 2	End of Fifth Six Weeks. All grades must be checked.
April 7-9	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until end of school day on April 9 th .
April 9	At the end of the school day, anyone with a failing grade on April 2 nd becomes ineligible for three school weeks. Anyone who was failing but is now passing all classes regains eligibility.
April 24	Anyone ineligible must have all grades checked and be passing all courses, not just the one or more they failed.
April 27-May 1	Grace Period. Students who failed a class are still eligible until end of school day on May 1 st .
May 1	Those who had been ineligible and passed all courses become eligible at the end of the school day.
